- 1. What is the difference between The Rapture and The Second coming of Christ? The Rapture is to remove The Church so God's wrath can start on earth. Anti-Christ: The political leader during tribulation

Babylon: Ancient city in the territory of Mesopotamia, modern day Iraq, south of Baghdad

Beast: The Anti-Christ, a political leader who will claim he is the Messiah

Beloved City: Jerusalem

Bride: The Church, Christians

Dragon/Age Old serpent: Satan

False Prophet: Religious leader who pays homage and follows the Beast

First Resurrection: The Righteous who have died in Christ, us, the Christians, The Church

Gog and Magog: Gog is the human Ruler of Russia; Magog is the land of Russia (Rosh)

Great Tribulation: The last 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years of the Tribulation period of an increasingly terrible

execution of God's wrath on earth to destroy those that oppose Him and Jesus

Great White Throne: God the Father

Lake of Fire: Eternal separation from God, continual burning in flames; literal lake

Second Death: Already sentenced to the Lake of Fire that cannot be reversed

The Church Age: All people who accept Jesus as the Son of God and as their Lord and

Savior from Jesus' death and resurrection to the rapture

The Dead: The people who reject Jesus. Non-believers at any time of being born

The Great City in Revelation 18:18,19: Babylon The Great

The Sea in Revelation 20:13: the literal sea, water, not land or earth. No one escapes judgement regardless of where you are buried.

Thrones in Revelation 20:4: The Christians from the Church Age, disciples of Jesus

Tribulation: A 7-year period of God's wrath on earth to all who reject His Son Jesus

Two Witnesses: Elijah and Enoch reference 2 Kings 2:11; Genesis 5:24; Hebrew 11:5
